

The Family Care Safety Registry (FCSR) provides valuable background information to employers hiring persons to care for children, seniors and physically and/or mentally disabled individuals.

Clarifying Error Messaging for Customer to Reduce Frustration

Ol Simplify to one generic message

Add a check box for "OTHER" for a "catchall" for special circumstances

Add check boxes to communicate what information is needed or the reason for the delay

Provide an estimated timeframe in which a response will be provided

- FUSION contains
 identifying information
 and demographic data for
 individuals with Driver
 and Non-Driver Licenses
- Enable FCSR staff to complete verifications without registrants or employers providing updates

Missouri's Family Care Safety Registry (FCSR) was established by law to promote family and community safety. The registry helps to protect children, seniors, and people with disabilities by providing background information. Families and employers can call the registry's toll-free line to request background information on registered child care, elder care, and personal care workers or to request licensure status information on licensed child care and elder care providers. This service is intended to provide information to help families and employers make informed decisions when hiring employees to work with children, the elderly, and people with disabilities.
